Diverting Green Waste is the Law



Properties must place plant debris in a designated organics collection container.*

- Business owners or managers can arrange for the removal of plant debris by their landscaper.
- CalRecycle now requires businesses to provide written documentation from the landscaper that the material is being hauled to a facility that composts it in order to receive compliance with the law.

NEW ON-CALL/ BULKY ITEM

CLEAN-UP FOR MULTI-FAMILY TENANTS

The ACI of San Leandro on-call/bulky item clean-up program allows for more recycling, reuse, and less waste.

Once a year, tenants can schedule an on-call/bulky item clean-up to be placed curbside that consists of up to three cubic yards of reusable items, recyclable materials, yard trimmings, solid waste, & bulky items. Properly Manage Household Hazardous Waste (HHW)

Hazardous waste does NOT belong in any ACI collection cart or bin.

Before disposal, check the label. If it's marked **Danger, Warning, Poisonous, Toxic, or Flammable**, it's hazardous and requires special handling. Many hazardous items can be taken to Alameda County's local HHW collection facility. Take advantage of this free drop-off program. For location, hours, and more info, visit StopWaste.org/hhw



SERVICE REMINDER California Law Requires Recycling & Composting

Participating fully in an organics and recycling waste diversion program is now required for every resident and business in the City of San Leandro.

"Sharps" is a medical term for devices with sharp points or edges that can puncture or cut skin such as needles, syringes, lancets, auto injectors (such as EpiPens), and infusion sets. PROPERLY SORT YOUR RECYCLABLES

Styrofoam®, plastic bags, film plastic, plastic wrap, non-recyclable packaging, masks, and gloves belong in your gray garbage container **NOT** the blue *recyclables* container.
