

Curbside Organics/Compost Collection

NEW! USED COOKING OIL*: Collect in one gallon or smaller, sealed screw-top containers less than 12" in height. Place next to (not inside) your organics cart, on the curb, not in the gutter.



HANDY KITCHEN PAIL: Use to collect food scraps and food-soiled paper in your home. When full, empty the pail into your **organics** cart. Need a pail? Contact us, we will deliver one.



Curbside Recyclables Collection

NEW! EXTRA CARDBOARD: Flatten, cut into pieces no larger than two feet by three feet, and stack next to your recyclables cart.



HOUSEHOLD BATTERIES: Place them in a zipper-lock style bag on top of (not inside) your recyclables collection cart. Tape terminals on nine-volt batteries. No automotive or liquid lithium-ion batteries are allowed.



USED MOTOR OIL AND OIL FILTER COLLECTION*: Place oil in one gallon or smaller, sealed screw-top containers less than 12"

in height. Place oil filters in sealed zipper-style bags. Place jugs and bags next to (not inside) your recyclables cart on the curb, not in the gutter. No other automotive liquids accepted.



Curbside Garbage/Landfill Collection

EXTRA GARBAGE TAGS: Overflow garbage will only be collected when you affix pre-paid tags to the bag(s). Contact us to buy tags or arrange for additional service.



*We will collect up to three gallons total of oil per week. **Do not mix oils in the containers.** Request oil jug and filter bag delivery by ACI.

Proper Curbside Set Out Follow these tips to help us provide safe, efficient service.



Be ready. Your carts must be at the curb by 6 am on your collection day. **What day?** Log into your online account or contact us to find out.

We can do this all day. Leave your carts out until we've emptied them. (Our trucks can arrive at different times each week.) Still think we missed you? Contact us to get your carts serviced.

Give us our space. When possible, leave three feet between each cart. Place carts facing the street with wheels against the curb, and keep them away from obstacles (parked cars, fire hydrants, low-hanging branches, etc.).

Don't be too much. Avoid overloading your carts. The lids should close completely. Don't wedge or compact materials to make them fit - this can cause litter and may prevent your cart from being fully emptied when serviced. Overflow garbage will only be collected when you affix pre-paid tags to the bag(s). Contact us to buy tags or arrange for additional service.

We have our limits (curbside).

Materials from construction, demolition, or landscaping projects do NOT belong in curbside carts. Call us to arrange temporary debris box service for these items.

Put it away. Remember to put your collection carts away and out of public view after servicing.

HAVE EXTRA OR BIG BULKY THINGS? USE THE ACI ON-CALL/BULKY ITEM CLEAN-UP PROGRAM

The ACI of San Leandro on-call/bulky item clean-up program allows for more recycling, reuse, and less waste. All single-family and multi-plex residential customers may schedule an annual on-call clean up to discard overflow waste, bulky items, reusable items, and recyclable materials.

A CLEAN UP COLLECTION INCLUDES:

- up to three cubic yards of reusable materials, recyclable materials, yard trimmings, and solid waste
- up to three bulky items one item may be e-waste
- available at no charge, twice per 12-month period



PLEASE NOTE

San Leandro Municipal Code prohibits the storage of Garbage, Recyclables, or Organics carts at the curb or on the street except on collection day.
