## Take Advantage of These Expanded Collection Services



### **NEW AND EXPANDED**

#### **ON-CALL/BULKY ITEM CLEAN-UP PROGRAM**

*The temporary bin system has been replaced with a new on-call/bulky item clean-up program placed curbside that allows for more recycling, reuse, employee safety, and less waste.*

Twice a year, single-family residents can schedule an on-call clean up that consists of up to three cubic yards placed curbside of reusable items, recyclable materials, yard trimmings, solid waste and bulky items. #### **EXTRA CARDBOARD**

Flatten, cut into pieces no larger than two feet by three feet (this is to ensure the pieces will fit in the hopper of the collection vehicle), and stack next to your **RECYCLABLES** cart.



#### **USED COOKING OIL\***

Collect in one gallon or smaller, sealed screw-top containers less than 12" in height. Place next to (not inside) your **ORGANICS** cart, on the curb, not in the gutter.

\*We will collect up to three gallons of used oil per week.

### **Avoid Wishcycling**

*Many times something you may think is recyclable actually isn't.* Items that are not recyclable can damage sorting machinery, injure our workers, and cause contamination - so **RECYCLABLES** end up in the landfill.

#### **COMMON WISHCYCLED ITEMS THAT DO NOT BELONG IN THE **RECYCLABLES** BIN:**

- Plastic film/bags/wrap
- Styrofoam®/packing peanuts
- Chip/snack packaging
- Crockery/dishware
- Soiled/wet paper
- CDs/VHS tapes
- Plastic plates/cups/cutlery

## **Reduce & Reuse by Using the Library of Things Collection & the Seed Lending Library**



### **THE LIBRARY OF THINGS (LOT) COLLECTION**

**Save space and money and reduce waste by checking out occasional use things for free with your San Leandro library card.** Items range from sewing kits and drills to mini induction cooktops and bird watching kits, there is something for everyone!

#### **HOW IT WORKS**

- Users must have a full access library card and be 18+ years old to place holds or check out "the things".
- Two LOT items can be checked out per card at one time and will be checked out for 21 days with no renewals. A waiver may be required for specific items. Items must be returned in person to the front desk of the Main or Manor library. **Patrons are expected to return items in good, clean condition.**

**A place for our community to share & trade seeds that have been harvested locally.**

Whether you are new to gardening or a seasoned master gardener, you can benefit from this seed library!
