### **NEW** ON-CALL/BULKY ITEM CLEAN-UP FOR MULTI-FAMILY TENANTS

The ACI of San Leandro clean-up program allows for more recycling, reuse, and less waste. Once a year, tenants can schedule an on-call/ bulky item clean-up to be placed curbside that consists of up to three cubic yards of reusable items, recyclable materials, yard trimmings, solid waste, & bulky items. # The Water Efficient Landscape Ordinance (WELO)

WELO is a statewide water conservation law\* for new and renovated landscapes.

The ordinance applies to any single-family or multi-family residential, public, institutional, or commercial project.

# How does the ordinance affect you? WELO applies to any project that:

- requires a permit, plan check, or design review from the local reviewing agency
- is a new construction project with a total landscape area greater than 500 square feet
- is a rehabilitation of an existing landscape with a total landscape area greater than 2,500 square feet
