- Buy only what you need. Plan your shopping trips and avoid wasted food. Use a meal planning tool to adjust your ingredients and portions accordingly.
- Send guests home with leftovers. Have guests bring empty containers or reuse clean empty food containers you've saved.
- Compost your food scraps. Use your handy kitchen pail to collect vegetable trimmings. Need a pail?

REDUCE WASTE WHEN GIVING

- Try second-hand first. Shopping at resale or thrift stores, or your local buy-nothing group, not only saves money, but keeps stuff out of the landfill.
- Shop at local stores. Shop local and support businesses that focus on sustainable, lasting goods. Try to avoid buying online, which creates additional packaging and transportation waste.
- Give experiences. Gift tickets to a museum exhibit, sporting event, gift cards to a local restaurant, or make home-cooked meals, baked goods, or homemade treats.

Real or Fake: Which Christmas Tree is Better for the Environment?*

Short answer—real! First off, real trees don't require the intensive carbon emissions that it takes to produce and ship artificial trees. Nearly 90% of artificial trees are shipped across the world from China, resulting in an increase of carbon emissions and resources. And most artificial trees are not recyclable and end up in local landfills.

Next, you're supporting forests and healthy soils. Out of the 350-500 million growing on tree farms across the U.S., only 30 million trees are harvested for the holidays each year. Buying real trees will help keep tree farms in business—and in turn keep their lands covered in the healthy forest habitat that supports wildlife. Once all the festivities are done, real trees can be recycled and given a second life as mulch/compost.

Holiday Tree Collection

ACI will collect holiday trees curbside from **Dec. 26 -Jan. 31** on your regular service day.

REMEMBER:

- Remove all decorations, lights, & the stand.
- Keep trees loose. Do not wrap or bag them.
- Cut your tree in half if it is taller than 6'.
- Small trees can be placed inside your ORGANICS cart.
- Flocked trees are accepted, but will not be composted.
- Artificial trees are not accepted and belong in the garbage when reuse is not an option. Contact us for collection info.

PLEASE NOTE: Tree collection will occur with special trucks at different times than your regular collection services.
