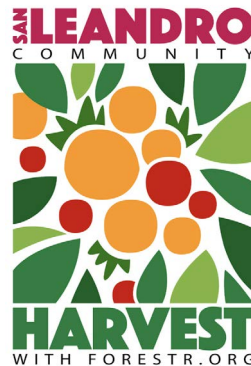


The official theme for Earth Day 2026 is "Our Power, Our Planet," a call to action for individuals to use their collective voice and power to protect the planet and build a sustainable future.

Holiday Service Schedule

There are **NO CHANGES** to the collection schedule during the weeks of Memorial Day or July 4th.

Take Advantage of These Curbside Collection Services



ON-CALL/BULKY ITEM/REUSE CLEAN-UP PROGRAM

Twice a year, single-family residents can schedule an on-call clean up that consists of up to three cubic yards placed curbside of reusable items, recyclable materials, yard trimmings, solid waste and bulky items. Rules apply. For more info, contact ACI or visit SanLeandroRecycles.com/clean-up

EXTRA CARDBOARD

Flatten, cut into pieces no larger than two feet by three feet (this is to ensure the pieces will fit in the hopper of the collection vehicle), and stack next to your **RECYCLABLES** cart.



USED COOKING OIL*

Collect in one gallon or smaller, sealed screw-top containers less than 12" in height. Place next to (not inside) your **ORGANICS** cart, on the curb, not in the gutter.

*We will collect up to three gallons of used oil per week. Cooking oil and motor oil must be separate. Do not mix oils in the containers. Request the delivery of oil jugs and filter bags by ACI.



GARBAGE

Avoid Wishcycling

Items that are not recyclable can damage sorting machinery, injure our workers, and cause contamination - so **RECYCLABLES** end up in the landfill.

COMMON WISHCYCLED ITEMS THAT DO NOT BELONG IN THE **RECYCLABLES** BIN:

- Plastic film/bags/wrap
- Styrofoam®/packing peanuts
- Chip/snack packaging
- Crockery/dishware
- Soiled/wet paper
- CDs/VHS tapes
- Plastic plates/cups/cutlery

STOPWASTE

A new StopWaste Regulatory Fee will appear on your garbage bill starting July 1, 2026. This small fee funds state-required programs that support composting and recycling, food waste reduction, edible food recovery and donation, and plastic bag pollution prevention.
